#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

## STABLING FEES

(Refer Annexure)

## **INITIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

All riders stabling horses at Broadlands Stables are required to provide the following at their own cost.

- · Halter, teff net, grooming kit, bucket for feed and water bucket.
- Day rug, sweat rug and winter blanket.
- Tack and any other odds and ends required.

#### **RIDING TIMES**

- The yard is open 7 days a week from 9 am to 6 pm.
  - If you wish to ride outside these times please make prior arrangements with the Stable Manager. On weekends only a skeleton staff is on duty. Should you wish to ride, please bear this in mind with regard to children requiring supervision.
- All horses are fed either twice or three times per day.
- If your riding time clashes with a feeding time please make prior arrangements with the Stable Manager.

# **HORSE SHOWS**

- Competitors are responsible for submitting their own entries.
- However, please inform your instructor of any shows you have entered and let them know your transport + groom arrangements at least 2 weeks prior to show. It is the client's responsibility to arrange transport for his/her horse/s.

## **SHOW SERVICE FEES**

It is not the intention to make a profit off show fees but to recover costs and remuneration for the instructor and grooms.

For groom- and instructor service fees, please refer our notice board.

## **SCHOOLING & LUNGING**

• If you require your horse/pony to be lunged or schooled, please make arrangements with the stable manager. Your account will be debited in advance with this amount.

#### **VETERINARY ATTENTION**

- The yard will attend to any small problems with your horse, however if deemed necessary, we will call the vet. We will make every attempt to contact you before this happens. However, in the event we are unable to get hold of you, we will call a Vet in the interests of the health and safety of your horse/s.
- Broadlands Equestrian Centre uses Pietersburg Vet Clinic. The Clinic will bill you directly for any
  visits or treatment, i.e. horse sickness, equine flu, de-worming and teeth filing. These are all for your
  own account. To facilitate this, on stabling your horse at Broadlands Equestrian Centre, please open
  an account at Pietersburg Vet Clinic at 217 Marshall Street, Polokwane.

## YARD RULES

- All riders must wear hard hats with elastic under the chin. We strongly recommend the new safety
  helmets now available in most reputable tack shops. Shoes with a heel must be worn (school shoes or
  veldskoene) or short (not long) riding boots, but never takkies or running shoes. This is for your own
  safety.
- We request that you provide a grooming kit for your horse / pony. This will be kept by the groom allocated to your pony / horse at your stable. Please mark items with a permanent marker.
- Riders must give way to lessons in progress. Lessons are held in the main arenas.
- The feed room is out of bounds; if your horse's diet needs to be changed, we request that you please discuss it with the Stable Manager.
- Tack is kept in a secure room; however, Broadlands Equestrian Centre cannot be held responsible for the loss of tack. However, every endeavor will be made to ensure the safekeeping of all equipment. We do suggest that you insure your tack with your insurance company.
- Horses may not be moved from their assigned stable to another without the authorization of the Centre Management.
- Horses must be kept off the lawns, and may NOT wander around the yard loose at any time.
- No children or juniors may jump without an instructor or parent present.
- If you find it necessary to alter jumps in the arena, please ensure that you return them to their original position.
- Please do not walk your horses through the pedestrian gates or sliding gate at the top of the yard where the Accommodation units are.
- After exercising you horse, please wash them down in the two crushers that are provided at the back or side of the yard, as washing them inside the courtyard makes a mess of your facilities. Please use these crushes for clipping and mane pulling.
- When your horse is stabled, please take care to close the stable door, as horses left outside in the
  enclosure are prone to having fights and crib bite. This is not only creating unnecessary wear and
  tear to the paddocks but the sharp pieces of wood digested are dangerous for your horse. These
  enclosures are there for your convenience when tacking up and grooming. Horses left outside their
  stables tend to jump out of the enclosures and can cause injuries. Outside paddocks are provided for
  the purpose of leaving horses out to dry, roll and play.
- The Dressage Arena and Jumping Arena <u>are out of bounds for rolling</u> your horses after having washed them down; please make use of the sandpit at the exit of the jumping arena for this purpose.
- The hose in the Courtyard may only be used to fill water buckets in the stables. There are two taps at the crush behind the stables for washing down horses and rinsing of bits, etc.
- Please do <u>not</u> graze your horse in the communal grounds or grass arena. Please graze your horse/s
  on the far side of the Dressage Arena or take them for a walk in the field.
- If lessons are being given in the various arenas, please ask permission from the instructors to use the same arena, or use the Grass or Dressage Arena. Riders, please, do not ride into the camps in front of your stables. This is extremely dangerous.

#### **ACCOUNTS**

- Stabling, lessons and show service fees will be billed in advance and must be paid before the 7th
  of each month. Shoeing will be done every four to six weeks. Transport, schooling, lunging etc. is
  billed in advance.

- All monies must be settled prior to your pony / horse leaving Broadlands Equestrian Centre.
- Should the stabling account remain unpaid for a period longer than two months, Broadlands Equestrian Centre reserves the right to sell the horse/s, pony/ies to defray expenses without further notice. Any balance received on the sale will be paid across to the client.

Neither Broadlands Equestrian Centre nor their representatives, nor the owners of Broadlands Farm shall be liable for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by any horses/ponies, rider, or accompanying children, parent or visitors or to their belongings either on Broadlands or in-transit to and from Broadlands.
